As a 20-year educator and administrator, in a variety of specialized environments (including magnet gifted and Montessori), I have worked with many gifted (and twice exceptional) learners and families. For the past five years in my practice, I have served many individuals, couples, and family systems where gifted traits and 2e traits are an important factor.

My experience also includes building community development skills like; cultivating a bully-free environment, diversity and cultural competency, stewardship, communication and respect, and advocacy for human-rights and social justice.

My masters degree, and current area of coaching/consulting focus, is in the field of applied positive psychology, or the study of human and organizational flourishing. In essence, my practice helps clients identify strengths/capacities/motivations to create positive deviance and healthier outcomes

in their lives and relationships. As a coach, I help clients leverage their talents and gifts to overcome challenges and build effective mindsets.

I have twenty-five years of experience working with gifted individuals and their systems of support. Working with gifted brains requires understanding of complexity, support navigating through ambiguity, and encouragement of self-directed growth. As a teacher of gifted learners, I endeavored to provide academic rigor in all core subjects and develop integrated, project-based curricula that engaged all students in critical and creative thinking skills; in short, programming that respected the integrity of the learners present. Beyond subject-matter, as both a teacher and an administrator, I valued building an environment that encouraged and fostered autonomy, inquiry, and challenging attitudes toward learning. Over twenty years, I have also created and adapted a variety of social/emotional programs that addressed affective needs, and supported developing learners through individual goal-setting with an emphasis on resilient/healthy mindsets, nurturing supportive relationships, and building organization and study skills.
